It will also provide simple child proofing tips and service provider strategies to reduce the risks to preconception, prenatal and child health. The workshop will help you identify the risks of highest concern in your community, and initiatives that will support or enhance existing programming.

This workshop will be of interest to service providers who work in the areas of preconception, prenatal and/or child health.
