Promote Safer Alternatives: Encourage the development and use of safer flame retardants that do not pose significant health and environmental risks. Supporting innovation and the adoption of safer alternatives can lead to more responsible fire safety practices.

Increase Public Awareness: Launch public awareness campaigns to inform Canadians about the potential risks associated with certain flame retardants and ways to minimize exposure. Empowering the public with knowledge will enable them to make informed choices and protect their families
