Person with Lived Experience of Multiple Chemical Sensitivity (MCS)

Ian Kuster, an Indigenous person from the Kwanlin Dün Nation in Yukon, shared his lived experience with Multiple Chemical Sensitivity (MCS), highlighting the years he spent without a diagnosis, safe housing, or adequate support. His testimony emphasized that clean air, accessible medical care, and healthy housing should be treated as fundamental human rights, not special accommodations. He called for a fair Canada where Indigenous people with MCS are met with understanding doctors, homes where people can breathe in health, and meaningful support that reaches every nation, territory, and community. His message was clear: no one should be left to suffer in silence, regardless of their ethnicity and location.
